#### Save the Dates:

You will get a "Save the Date" letter from me 1-2 months prior to the date of your child's scheduled IEP meeting. Please make sure to contact me as soon as possible if the date you receive does not work for you.

#### Invitation letters:

You will receive a formal invitation letter 2 weeks prior to your child's scheduled IEP meeting. The letter looks a little different this year and the response you will check and sign to send back is on the same page. You will also get a Strengths and Needs summary form which we use to fill out the Childhood Outcomes Summery (COS) portion of the IEP. Your input is valuable and we'd appreciate if you could send it back to use at least a week before the meeting date.
